SC rejects plea for SIT probe into alleged judges bribery case

New Delhi

The Supreme Court on Tuesday dismissed a plea seeking an SIT probe into an alleged case of bribery in the name of judges, saying it was "wholly scandalous".

It also deprecated the conduct of advocates in filing petitions aimed at bringing disrepute to the institution without any rhyme or reason.

The apex court said the plea was filed to "create ripples" in the judiciary by making allegations against the Chief Justice of India and an attempt was also made for "forum hunting" by seeking recusal of one of the judge's of the bench, which tantamounts to contempt of court.

The top court expressed displeasure while rejecting the petition filed by advocate Kamini Jaiswal, saying senior advocate Shanti Bhushan and lawyer Prashant Bhushan had made "unfounded allegations" against the system and the CJI.

Criticising the attempt to seek recusal of one of the judges in the matter, a bench of Justices R K Agrawal, Arun Mishra and A M Khanwilkar said, "We find that it is another attempt to bring the system in disrepute. Casting of unwarranted aspersions tantamounts to seriously jeopardising the independ-

ence of the judiciary". The petition had claimed few days to unrest.

'JUDICIARY'S INDEPENDENCE CAN'T BE AT MERCY OF CBI OR POLICE'

Independence of judiciary cannot be left "at the mercy **L**of the CBI or police", the Supreme Court on Tuesday observed while reiterating that no FIR can be lodged against a sitting judge of the apex court or the high courts.

A three-judge bench headed by Justice R K Agrawal referred to a 1991 constitution bench judgement that had held that registration of FIRs against sitting judges of the higher judiciary was not permissible.

"Thus, the instant petitions as filed, are a misconceived venture inasmuch as the petition wrongly presupposes that investigation involves higher judiciary, that is this court's functionaries are under the scanner in the aforesaid case; that independence of judiciary cannot be left at the mercy of the CBI or that of the police is a red herring," the bench, also comprising Justices Arun Mishra and A M Khanwilkar, said.

The apex court said there was no "reflection" of any name of the judge of apex court in the FIR lodged by the CBI in the case in which allegations of bribery were levelled for securing settlement of cases relating to medical colleges. "Any complaint against a judge and investigation by the CBI if given publicity, will have a farreaching effect on the judge and the litigant public. The need, therefore, is of judicious use of action taken under the Act," the bench said.

Referring to the constitution bench verdict of 1991, the top court said it had observed that in order to ensure independence of judiciary, the apprehension that the executive being the largest litigant, it was likely to misuse the power to prosecute the judges.

After five-day-long multicity searches, Income Tax (I-T) department sleuths had detected undisclosed income of Rs 1,430 crore in respect of 10 assessee groups which included those linked to Sasikala,

ates. Meanwhile, police said I-T officials were on Tuesday verifying documents at the Green Tea Estate at Curzon in Nilgiris district. The estate is said to be purchased by late chief minister Jayalalithaa and her aide Sasikala some five years ago.

Jayaraman told reporters here that I-T sleuths posed various questions about companies headed by him, including Jazz Cinemas, besides seeking accounts for the jewels worn by his wife during their wedding. He said it was explained

Narmada sand up...

With the new policy coming into force, mining of sand from Narmada river would resume. Sand-laden trucks, dumpers and tractor-trolleys will not be subjected to any checking on the highways and other roads. However, mechanised mining will not be allowed.

A couple of months back, chief minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan had announced a blanket ban on mining sand from the bed of Narmada river. Mechanised mining was banned on all rivers.

The government held two press conferences to announce the new policy on Tuesday. First, Narottam Mishra, spokesperson for the government, informed about the new policy to the mediapersons immediately after the cabinet meeting. In the evening, mining minister Rajendra Shukla addressed another press conference on the same issue.

Under the new policy, the urban civic bodies and panchayats would control the presently non-operational sand mines. The operational sand mines would continue to be governed by the older policy. Of the Rs 125 royalty, Rs 50 would go to the panchayat concerned, Rs 50 to District Mineral Foundation and Rs 25 to Mining Corporation.

Shukla said that the royalty would have to be paid online. According to Shukla, there are 1,266 sand mines in the state of which only 445 have been auctioned. The new policy would be applicable to the 821 non-operational mines.

I-T raid on...

Though the group's major business operations and manufacturing plants are based in Indore and its vicinity, the income-tax returns were filed in Kolkata, that has of late gained notoriety as a hub of shell or briefcase companies. The raids are to continue for next three four days. The actual data of money laundering and I-T evasion would be ascertained only after it.

Translocation of lions from Gir to Kuno Palpur has been a bone of contention between two BJP rules states for more than a decade with Prime Minister Narendra Modi terming the big cats as "pride of Gujarat" which the state cannot share with others. He made this statement when he was Gujarat's chief minister between 2002 and 2014.

The committee during its last meeting held in December 2016 in Kuno, in which officials from Gujarat forest department also participated, reiterated that the wildlife habitat was "ideally suited to become second home for lions."
